Why should we participate?

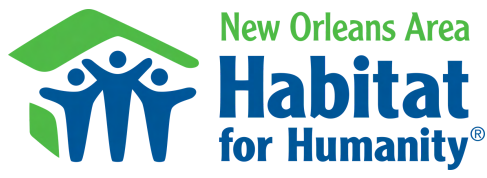
